### ARIEF SCHOLARSHIP

*These one-time awards will be payable to the recipient's educational institution for tuition.*

### ELIGIBILITY

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible for the scholarship. The candidate:

- is an Awards and Personalization Association member company owner, the child or grandchild of an Association member company owner, an employee of an Association member company, or the child or grandchild of an Association member company employee
- is enrolled full-time, either as a high school senior or a college student at the undergraduate level
- has declared any chosen area of educational focus
- has a 3.0 minimum grade point average at the time of application (include transcripts or official record).

### SELECTION PROCESS

Recipients will be selected by the Awards and Recognition Industry Educational Foundation trustees based on application materials provided. All scholarship applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in February 2023. Payment will be made to the recipient's school of choice upon notification and in accordance with the school's scholarship guidelines. Recipients will be announced at the International Awards & Personalization Expo on February 7–10, 2023.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Application materials must be received by December 16, 2022, to be considered. The following materials must be submitted:

1. Completed application form (found on next page).
2. A typed essay (no more than one page, double-spaced) addressing one of the following topics:
  - a. Describe an accomplishment you have been recognized for and its influence on you.
  - b. If you could give an award to one person who has most positively influenced our world, who would it be and why?
  - c. How can the practice of recognizing or awarding individuals build character in today's society?
3. One letter of reference or recommendation from a teacher, coach, or other adult who is not an immediate relative.
4. Transcripts or official record of GPA.

A resumé is optional.
